



## STUDENT COMMUNICATIONS OFFICER

STUDENT COMMUNICATORS work under the supervision of career communications officers. They receive and route calls for fire, police, and emergency medical services to the appropriate agency. During the calls for service, communicators maintain radio contact with responding units to pass information and requirements between units. They perform data input, maintain the warrant files, make computer inquiries, and generally assist medics, police officers, and firefighters in the performance of their duties. Student communicators work varying shifts, usually about six hours and average just less than 30 hours per week. More work is usually available based on individual qualifications.

## CRITERIA AND BENEFITS

---

### **Student Public Safety Program Members:**

- Are paid for all hours worked, and are eligible for pay increases based on job performance
- Must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA and regular progress toward a degree
- Are paid for hours worked and spent in training
- Receive paid tuition when assigned to a shift and with a 2.5 GPA or higher
- Are eligible for step raises over time
